**Transport:**

Transport is best via private car or coach. Alternatively the Transborder Alpine Express bus takes you to Jindabyne visitors centre or Friday Flat in Thredbo (in winter). In addition, Snow Link (local transportation) will drop off at Alpine Habitats. The taxi service is available to be booked for transport from Jindabyne or Thredbo. Rex airlines flies to Cooma airport where shuttle buses and hire cars are also available.

**Parking:**

Parking is available both at reception and directly outside each habitat. The maximum distance of travel from parking to the front door is 30m. The carpark areas are flat with ample room for loading and unloading a wheelchair or stroller.

**Entry:**

Ramped entry is available to reception, however, ramped entry to accommodation is still under construction.

**Reception:**

There is parking and a ramp to reception, however, the manager lives on site and would be happy to meet people with access needs at their habitat



**Accommodation:**

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Each habitat is a self contained, environmentally friendly living area. There are two habitats which have been developed with accessibility in mind. The entry to the units is currently being adapted to incorporate a ramp, similar to that at reception. The entry door is 900mm width. The light switches are located at 750mm height and the heater control at 1470mm height switches are easily accessible being located not within 500mm of internal corners. The floor in the habitat is cement with floor rugs placed around the living area. The floor is heated and there is a methylated fueled fire place. The kitchen bench is 750mm height and there is no knee space in the kitchen area.



### Bedrooms:

The entry door to the bedroom is 850mm wide with a lever handle at 1020mm height. The bed is king size but can be split into two single beds. The height of the bed is 550mm there is no space available under the bed for a hoist. When the bed is in the king size format it is

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generally placed with 800mm distance to the wall on both sides of the bed. Height of hanging space in the bedroom is 1850mm in a wardrobe with outward opening doors. The mirror is 690mm minimum height above the ground. There is adequate circulation space in the room.



## Bathroom:

The entry door to the bathroom is 850mm wide with a lever handle at 1020mm height. The shower has a flat entry with a glass screen along the side. The shower has a hand held and adjustable rose with 2 star capstan taps at a height of 1000mm there is a grab rail above the taps at a height of 1100mm. A shower chair is available on request.

The toilet is left hand transfer and the seat height is 450mm. The distance of the centerline of the seat to the wall is 460mm, and front of the seat to rear is 800mm. There are currently no grab rails beside or behind the toilet. The basin dimensions are 800 mm height with 630 mm knee space and a depth of 220 mm. The basin has a single lever tap with a mixer at a height of 930mm.



## Emergency:

A documented emergency procedure is displayed on the door of each cottage. The alarm is audio and a Warden will seek to evacuate guests to safe refuge. Exit from the site would be via the driveway.
