

## **Cooma Twin Cinema**

You can catch the latest movies at Cooma's twin cinema. The cinema is open Friday, Saturday, Sunday & Tuesday everyday of the year (except Xmas Day). During school holidays and long weekends they open 7 days per week. Session times can be found on the Snowy Movies website. To ensure access to the cinema you will need to pre arrange with cinema staff prior to your arrival.

### **Transport:**

Transport is available via private car or coach. The Transborder Alpinexpress bus takes you to Cooma Town Centre. There is no wheelchair accessible taxi service available in Cooma.

### **Parking:**

There is adequate street level parking available outside the cinema. However, there are no designated accessible parking spaces within 60 metres of the entrance.

### **Approach and Entry:**

The main entry to the cinema is via a flight of 10 stairs. It is possible to organise an accessible entry by contacting the cinema prior to arrival. The flat entry follows the driveway beside the cinema to the rear of the building where you enter through the printing shop, The cinema holds a key to this door. The door will be left unlocked if access is pre organised. The door is a heavy inwards opening push door with minimum door width 810mm, for exit the pull handle is at 1120mm.



## Cooma Twin Cinema

### **Ticket and Food Counter:**

The counter for ticket and food sales is 900mm with no knee space. The area is well lit with clear signage. There is plenty of circulation space in the foyer area, the floor surface is carpet.



### **Cinema**

The downstairs theatre is the only one of the two movie theatres that is accessible. Movies are rotated between two cinemas so all movies are available in the accessible cinema. Travel from the ticket counter to the accessible theatre is via a ramp (gradient 13%). The theatre has a flat entry through a 940mm door which remains open during session times. There is a seating space for a wheelchair in the back row of the cinema (see photos). There is no hearing augmentation loop in this cinema.



### **Toilet:**

Male and female stall toilets are available from the foyer, However, there is no designated accessible toilet available.

### **Emergency:**

A documented emergency procedure is displayed. The cinema has a visual alarm and exit signs. There is also an audio alarm which will sound and a Warden will seek to evacuate guests to safe refuge. Emergency entry/exit points are at the front and rear of the theatre.
