

Jindabyne Memorial Hall

Thredbo Terrace
Jindabyne NSW 2627

The Jindabyne Memorial Hall is situated near the 'Old Shopping Centre' on the corner of Kosciuszko Rd and Thredbo Terrace in Jindabyne. The hall is used throughout the area as required for activities ranging from town meetings to activity classes (such as karate and yoga) to art shows.

Transport:

Transport is available via private car or coach. An accessible taxi service is available to be booked for transport. The Transborder Alpinexpress bus takes you to Jindabyne visitor centre where there it is possible to walk (~200m) to the Memorial Hall.

Parking:

Two designated disabled parking spaces are available approximately 30m from the entrance to the hall. There is a ramp (7% gradient, 15m long, 1800 mm wide) that leads to the main entrance and public toilets.



Entry:

There is one step of approximately 10cm to enter the foyer area. Access to the hall is through double glass doors (minimum single door width 840mm) with a knob handle (height 1060mm) and an automatic door closer. Once inside all areas are flat and there are wide doorways. The floor surface is tiled in the foyer and wooden floor boards in the hall.



Emergency:

A documented emergency procedure is displayed. The alarm is audio and a Warden will seek to evacuate guests to safe refuge. The building has a number of emergency entry/exit points.

Toilet:

An accessible unisex designated accessible public toilet is situated just outside the hall. The door width is 1000mm with a knob handle (height 1120mm). There is adequate circulation space in the toilet room. There is a horizontal grabrail at 820mm leading to a diagonal grabrail with a maximum height of 1320mm. The basin height is 1020mm with 820mm knee space and a depth of 420mm. The mirror is 1240mm at its lowest point.
