### **Transport:**

Transport is available via private car or coach, the Transborder Alpinexpress bus takes you to Cooma town centre where there is a good path of travel (~1km) to the Cooma RSL.

### **Parking:**

Parking is available either in the parking yard out the back of the club or on the street. There are 3 parking spaces close to the rear entrance.

### **Entry:**

There is currently stairs at both the front and rear entrances, however, there is work being undertaken on an elevator at the front of the building and ramp access at the rear. The doors at the front entry are automatic the floor surface inside the entry is carpet. The door at the rear entrance is a heavy push door.

### **Bistro:**

Once inside the Ex-Services Club everything is located on a single level. The Bistro area is a flat carpeted open plan dining area. The height of the food ordering area is 950mm and the height of the bar (for drinks) is 1150mm. There is good lighting and clear signage throughout the facility. Tables in the bistro are pedestal style at 730mm height, with 710mm clear knee space. There is ample circulation space between the tables. The menu for the bistro is displayed on a blackboard behind the ordering counter.

### **Toilet:**

The ex-services club has an accessible unisex toilet and baby change facility. The door width is 900mm and the door is easy to open with one hand. The toilet has a side grab rail (800mm height).

### **Emergency:**

A documented emergency procedure is displayed. The alarm is audio and a Warden will seek to evacuate guests to safe refuge. The building has a number of emergency entry/exit points.
