

Swampy Plains River Walk

Alpine Way

On the road between Thredbo & Khancoban NSW

Along the Alpine Way approximately 17km past Tom Groggin is the Geehi camping area and the Swampy Plains River Walk. Located on level ground, most features have relatively easy access. There is an information display and a covered picnic table.

Transport:

The only transport is via private vehicle via a sealed road.

Parking:

Flat parking on gravel surface is available however there is no dedicated accessible parking.

Path of Travel:

Unsealed roads and parking area with sealed paths leading to the river walk. Sealed path (bricked pavement) of approximately 300metres in length varies from flat to gently sloping and is wide enough for wheelchair and person walking beside (varying from 1-1.4m wide). Frequent rest areas with seats make this camping ground and river walk easy to negotiate.

Facilities:

The BBQ and picnic area contains BBQ's and tables for public use. Those using a wheelchair are able to circulate around the undercover area and be situated close to the table.



Emergency:

Emergency exit from the site would be via the driveway and Alpine Way.

Toilet:

Toilets are of the composting variety. Male & Female toilets with grab rails. Angled, front and side toilet transfers moving from the wheelchair to the right. Basin outside the cubicle.
