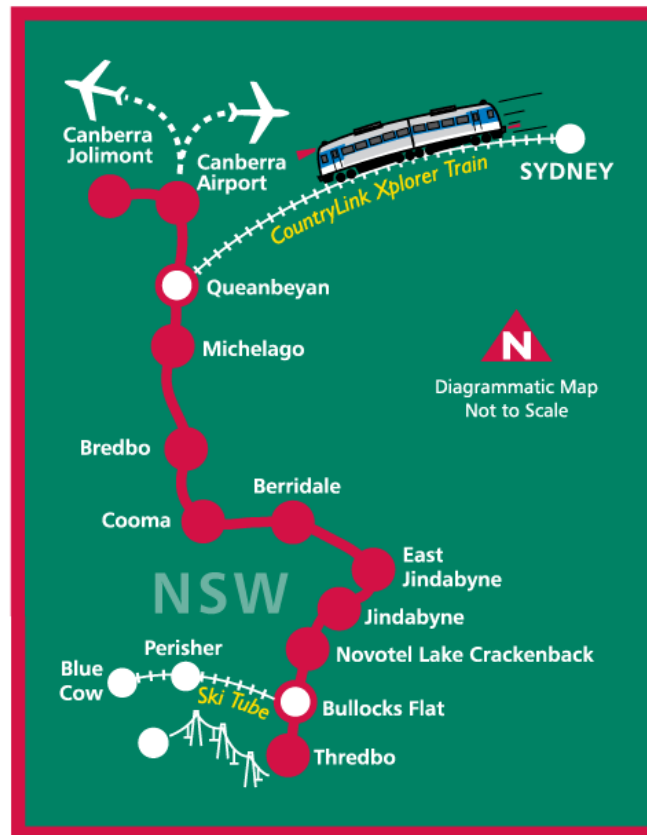


Transborder Alpinexpress Bus Service

The Transborder Alpinexpress bus is the only coach transport link from Canberra to the Alpine region operating in the summer time. The journey follows the Monaro Highway to the important regional centre of Cooma followed by the Snowy Mountains Highway and Alpine Way to Jindabyne and Thredbo. During summer the bus travels to and from the alpine region once daily passing through Jindabyne around lunchtime, during winter the bus travels to the snowfields in the morning and returns in the late afternoon.

The Alpinexpress buses provide accessible transport for people with limited access needs. The bus lowers to sidewalk level there is then a set of 4 stairs with handrails on either side leading up into the bus, assistance from the driver is available on request. Once in the bus there is a narrow aisle which allows support by holding the seats on either side while walking to your seat. A front seat is available on request when booking. Prams, walking frames and bikes can be stored under the bus for transport.





The Alpinexpress bus does not provide access for wheel chairs at this stage, however, development towards a wheel chair accessible bus is in the pipeline within the next 5 years. The larger Transborder/Countrylink buses which travel from Canberra to Bega and Bombala do have wheel chair access facilities.
