They operate a large 4WD vehicle that seats 13 (pictured below).

They operate several 11 seat vehicles (pictured below) together with two Landcruisers that carry 8 passengers. Access to these smaller vehicles is similar to standard vehicles although a little higher.

All vehicles are air conditioned. The company is aware of accessibility issues and is happy to assist where possible.

### **Transport:**

Transport to Mansfield is available via private car or V/Line provide a daily service to & from Melbourne. The company will collect patrons from the Vline depot and transfer to their accommodation.

High Country Scenic Tours will arrange to pick up and drop off patrons at their accommodation (conditions apply).

### **The Vehicle**

#### **Entry:**

Access to the vehicle is via a side door. The bottom of the doorway is 1070mm high. The doorway itself is 670mm wide and 1280mm high. The door is reached via three steps which, from the bottom, are 450mm, 310mm and 310mm. The company has an extra step available to reduce the first step. This should be requested when booking. At the top of the steps there is circulation space of 760mm x 1000mm. There are hand holds to assist with entry.

The seats are 440mm high have removable or foldable (up) armrests. The seats are high backed, have lap sash seat belts and have knee clearance of 310mm from the front of the seat to the back of the seat in front.

Wheelchairs can be taken on the bus however this would need to be arranged and prices negotiated when booking.

A popular trip in the High Country is Craig's Hut rebuilt after the Great Divide Fires of 2007/8. There is limited access for wheelchairs from the bottom step to the walking path. However, once on the footpath access is greatly enhanced, with easy travelling into the hut. Also the toilet area is user friendly with a concrete floor.
